

New Line Learning Academy's Home Learning Agreement

Students and parents/carers should read the Home Learning Agreement below and sign to confirm they will follow the terms of the agreement.

As a student, I will:

- Attend regularly and on time to achieve a minimum of 95% attendance and complete as many streaks as I can.
- Speak to the teachers of any lessons that I miss and record these conversations in my 360
- Wear the correct uniform at all times
- Always have my planner to hand
- Be prepared for every lesson with the necessary equipment and kit
- Adopt a positive attitude of hard-work, self-discipline and organisation in every lesson and ensure that deadlines are met
- Produce work to the best of my ability, taking care over presentation
- Show RESPECT, be honest, polite, considerate and well behaved during social and lesson times
- Not use my own electronic devices during the school day

As a parent/carer, I will:

- Ensure that my child achieves a minimum of 95% attendance, is punctual to school every day and that I will contact the school when they are absent
- Attend parents' evenings and maintain communication with the school about my child's progress
- Check and sign the student 360 each week and use this as my main form of communication with the school
- Send my child to school in the correct uniform
- Check that my child has the correct equipment and kit each day
- Provide my child with the relevant support and resources to ensure that they are able to access and complete learning to the best of their ability
- Support the academy's policies for behaviour, learning, rewards and consequences

- Act 'in Loco Parentis'
- Take every reasonable measure to ensure the safety of students and staff on site
- Have high expectations of your child with regards to attendance, presentation, conduct and outcomes
- Communicate home any concerns that we may have
- Follow and enforce all school policies, including those in relation to attendance, uniform, behaviour and conduct
- Deliver appropriately challenging and engaging lessons
- Mark your child's class and homework regularly and show them how to make good progress
- Provide enrichment opportunities, including those through the setting of homework
