Literacy

Literacy Intervention is delivered via the Literacy team. On entry, pupil's reading ages are tested and tested again when deemed ready. Of the 47 pupils identified as requiring additional literacy intervention, 13 have been retested and made significant improvement. This is detailed below.

Numeracy

Numeracy Intervention is delivered via the Ninja Maths intervention programme. Gaps in knowledge are identified and additional support provided by a Maths teacher. Ninja Maths is delivered to pupils as part of their period 1 studies.

- 42 pupils below average progress in Maths on entry
- 86% now on track for expected progress
- 50% on track to exceeded expected progress
- 5 pupils back on national average progress

Numeracy

- 92% now on track for expected progress
- 62% on track to exceeded expected progress
- 12 pupils back on national average progress
